

Updated Supply List 7-15-2026:

professional oil paints – titanium white, cad yellow lt, cad red lt, ultramarine blue, yellow ochre, burnt sienna and an optional green (I like viridian) as a base palette. I currently use williamsburg oils. Feel free to use your brand of choice.

extra/exotic colors (opt.) - I like having a few depending on the mood and will be discussing this as well as sharing my experiences with the different brands. A few I like to have: manganese violet, cobalt blue, cerulean blue (one of my favorites), sevres or king's blue, persian pink, veronese green.

your favorite brushes – bristle flats and rounds 4, 8, 12, etc. (better quality less quantity)

brush holder

brush cleaner with sealable lid (I use linseed or walnut oil in mine, sometimes o.m.s.)

painting knife

linseed oil or medium of choice

easel – french box, tripod with palette, etc. (test your setup ahead of time)

plein air umbrella (opt.)

hat (opt.)

thin painting gloves (opt.) (test ahead of time)

paper towel roll

baby wipes

small waste bags

portable chair (opt.)

handheld mirror (opt.)

several linen/canvas panels - your favorite 8x10, 9x12, 11x14, etc.
